

Constitution of The Grand Republic of Moontonia



PREAMBLE

WE, the founders of these states, with the intent to form a perfect nation, do declare this land to be under the protection and ruling of the Supreme Leader for all eternity. We, the great founders of this land, deem these states united, and hence, shall prosper.

Article I - Names

SECTION 1 - THE NAME of these states shall be **The Grand Republic of Moontonia**, hereafter referred to as Moontonia The government of Moontonia reserves the right to use whichever version of the name they deem necessary.

SECTION 2 - THE NAME of the group of elites at the top, shall be dubbed **The Supreme Cabinet** of Moontonia hereafter referred to as The Cabinet or The Supreme Cabinet.

Article II - Duties of Moontonia and Cabinet

SECTION 1 - The Moontonia shall uphold the basic laws of nature by not disturbing the food chain directly, not directly harming the environment, not deforesting, and so on. We shall protect and preserve nature as our ancestors once did. We shall strive to keep the citizens happy and equal while maintaining order. The Moontonia shall also adhere to its laws, either voted on, instated by the cabinet, or the Supreme Leader.

SECTION 2 - The Cabinet shall act as the high order of the Moontonia It shall decide the most significant of issues: court, law, and civil. The Cabinet will also act as the high decision-maker of the nation. No decision by The Cabinet can be overruled by anyone but The Cabinet itself or the Supreme Leader, but criticism is allowed if deemed justified by The Cabinet. The Cabinet has the right to the following: Overriding the decisions of court cases, vetoing laws made by Governors, creating laws for the country (without a vote from the Senate.)The Cabinet also has the right to declare Supreme Military Rule, a state where there is an emergency of so much significance that The Cabinet must cut off the entire government except for The Cabinet itself. In this state, no laws apply to The Cabinet, meaning The Cabinet will ensure the survival of the country and its ideals at any cost. The Cabinet does not have the right to override votes made by the Senate, that power is reserved only for the Supreme Leader.

Article III - Citizenship and Taxes

SECTION 1 - Citizenship of this nation shall be chosen without discrimination based on race, color, religion, age, national origin, disability, marital status, veteran status, sexual orientation, or gender. Citizens must provide the Minister of Immigration with a correct and legal name. The legality of the name will be decided by the Minister of Immigration, using records from the citizens' country of origin as evidence.

SECTION 2 - Citizenship of this nation includes with it the right to food, a clean and reliable source of water, shelter, protection by self or military, request assistance, have a job, pay taxes, leave and enter the nation willingly, religion, and the right to own physical property. These rights will be held and protected to the utmost of the nation's ability.

SECTION 3 - Citizenship cannot be taken away by a lack of participation. Citizenship can only be removed once the citizen wishes it. However, the Minister of Immigration holds the right to deny permission to revoke citizenship, but this will cause no problems for the citizen. Only on paper will they continue to be a citizen of the nation.

SECTION 4 - Every year citizens of the nation must pay tax on their Moontonia made their income for the previous year. This tax will be twenty percent of the citizens' previous year's income and will be paid to the government within one week before April 20th Gregorian, May 26th Moontonian. All taxes will be due on April 20th Gregorian, June 26th Moontonian. If a citizen fails to pay these taxes, the court will decide the punishment. Senate and Cabinet members are not required to pay this tax. A verbal or written statement. If written it must be signed by the citizen it pertains to and must be submitted to the Senate to inform the tax collectors that a certain Senate or Cabinet member will not be paying their yearly taxes.

Article IV - Members of the Cabinet

SECTION 1 - The members of The Cabinet shall be as follows: The Supreme General Commander Grand Sergeant Major Chief Master Sergeant Supreme Leader King, The Supreme Grand General of the Armed Forces, The Commander of Religion and Sciences, The Supreme Governor, The Brigadier General of the Border Guard, and the Commander of Security. All members of The Cabinet are granted the rights of The Cabinet.

SECTION 2 - A member of The Cabinet may only be impeached or appointed by the Supreme Leader.

SECTION 3 – If a member of The Cabinet is impeached or resigns a new member will be appointed by the Supreme Leader.

Article V - Duties of the Cabinet Members

SECTION 1 - THE DUTIES OF THE SUPREME LEADER

Supreme Leader - To preside at votes, court cases, diplomatic missions, meetings; appoint members to The Cabinet; To uphold law and order; To ensure the smooth growth of the nation; To ensure maintenance on the nation; To ensure lawfulness and sovereignty of the nation; To command the Air Force; To smoothly run the state of Moonvia; To participate in cabinet meetings, and to represent the nation with or without the Ambassador.

SECTION 2 - THE DUTIES OF THE SUPREME GRAND GENERAL OF THE ARMED FORCES

The Supreme Grand General - To preside in the Supreme Leader's absence and perform the duties of upholding law and order; To ensure the safety of the nation; To ensure the military might and success of the nation; To command the army; To smoothly run the state appointed to them; To participate in cabinet meetings.

SECTION 3 - THE DUTIES OF THE BRIGADIER GENERAL OF THE BORDER GUARD

Brigadier General of the Border Guard - To ensure the safety of the Moontonia's borders; To maintain the Moontonia's borders; To command the border guard; To ensure the safety of the government; To smoothly run the state appointed to them; To participate in cabinet meetings.

SECTION 4 - THE DUTIES OF THE SUPREME GOVERNOR

Supreme Governor - To ensure the safety and smooth operation of the states of the Moontonia other than Dytusstein and Moonvia; To create laws and ensure those laws along with the Moontonia's laws are being upheld in the states other than Dytusstein and Moonvia; To ensure the Supreme Leader and Supreme Grand General are informed of the current situation of the States other than Dytusstein and Moonvia if there is a problem or change; To smoothly run the state appointed to them; To participate in cabinet meetings.

SECTION 5 - THE DUTIES OF THE COMMANDER OF SECURITY

Commander of Security - To maintain surveillance on the citizens and work with the law to ensure laws are being followed; To ensure and maintain the security of The Cabinet; To maintain a military presence to uphold the law and capture criminals; To smoothly run the state appointed to them; To participate in cabinet meetings.

SECTION 6 - THE DUTIES OF THE COMMANDER OF RELIGION AND SCIENCES

Commander of Religion and Sciences - To ensure that the Moontonia achieves scientific progress along with ensuring the laws regarding religion are being upheld to the highest standard; To speak with and gain the blessing of Munchy; To smoothly run the state appointed to them; To participate in cabinet meetings.

Article VI - Voting and Elections

SECTION 1 - Voting on laws, amendments, or other topics deemed appropriate by the Supreme Leader or The Cabinet is to be held at any time of day, with no required prior notice, and no one is required to vote. The people who can vote, and how much their vote is worth, is outlined in The List. The vote can be started or ended by either the Supreme Leader or The Cabinet without advance notice. A majority vote is needed for it to pass.

SECTION 2 - Elections will never be held for The Cabinet. All members of The Cabinet will be appointed by the Supreme Leader.

SECTION 3 - Elections for the Senate will only be held in The Cabinet. Each member will vote, with each person's vote being worth one. The candidate with the majority wins the election. The Supreme Leader holds the right to skip the voting process and appoint anyone they choose to a Senate position.

Article VII - Amendments

SECTION 1 - Amendments to this Constitution may be added by the Supreme Leader, added by The Cabinet, or voted on and added by the Senate.

SECTION 2 - THE AMENDMENTS

AMENDMENT ONE: The Supreme Leader holds the supreme right to overrule any law, document, decision, or anything else.

AMENDMENT TWO: If the Supreme Leader deems himself unfit to perform his duties, then the chain of command will pass down the order of the Cabinet and then the Senate. The order of the Cabinet is as follows: The Supreme Leader, The Supreme Grand General, The Brigadier General of the Border Guard, The Supreme Governor, The Commander of Security, The Commander of Religion and Sciences. If there are still functioning Cabinet members, and if the Supreme Leader is unable to give the go ahead, then the remaining Cabinet members will vote on if the member next in line is fit to be the acting Supreme Leader. If there are no more cabinet members left, then the Senate will vote to give the go-ahead. If the Supreme Leader is able to give the go ahead, then their word will bypass all votes.
